#### RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a permit with conditions on the application of Austin Plong Physician Assistant, Inc., DBA Pka Roam Tek Roam Restaurant, 1360 East Anaheim Street, Suite 205, for Entertainment with Dancing by Patrons. (District 6)

#### **DISCUSSION**

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council shall approve the issuance of the entertainment permit if they find that: the issuance of the permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) or any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Department of Financial Management every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application and floor plan. To review all supportive documents, as well as the documents included in this report, you may visit www.longbeach.gov/finance/business relations/entertainment.asp.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

 The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to the conditions. HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL December 3, 2013 Page 2

- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence. Since the issuance of the applicant's Conditional Business License and Probationary Entertainment Permit, no violations have occurred. The applicant has been compliant and cooperative during the application process. After a thorough investigative process, the Department of Financial Management recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant with alcohol since May 2008.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on November 14, 2013.

#### **TIMING CONSIDERATIONS**

The hearing date of December 3, 2013, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$22 and Zoning Review \$16 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,240 (Police Department), and Mailing List \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$337.30 and Regulatory \$1,025 (Financial Management Department).

### **Recommended Conditions of Operation**

Austin Plong Physician Assistant, Inc., dba: Pka Roam Tek Roam Restaurant 1360 East Anaheim Street, Suite #205, Long Beach, CA 90813 Application for Entertainment With Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

#### I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80). If any noise or disturbance complaints can be attributed to the speaker volume, the permittee shall modify or remove existing speakers at the direction of the Chief of Police.
- 4) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 5) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M.
- 6) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 7) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per

fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification.

Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 9) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 10) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 11) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 12) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment after 10:00 P.M. for the sole purposes of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver's license or identification card.

- 13) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 14) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 15) All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License **prior to** conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters.
- 16) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation. The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 17) The business, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent and promoter's contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 18) If the permittee utilizes an independent third party event promoter to provide entertainment related services resulting in any public safety call for service, the City reserves the right to remove and/or restrict the use of independent third party promoters.
- 19) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 20) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the TIPS or LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety-day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be

submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section. The permittee shall keep employees proof of completion on file and available for inspection at any time.

#### II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M. Sunday through Thursday nights, and between 10:00 A.M. and 12:00 A.M. Midnight Friday and Saturday nights.
- 2) There shall be no amplified music or live entertainment permitted in the patio area at any time
- 3) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor to remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition.
- 4) The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, into a dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with **regular dining or pre-planned banquet activities**. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d-oeuvers shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 5) The permittee shall not require an admission or cover charge for entry to any event taking place at the establishment.
- 6) This entertainment permit is an accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to use remaining as a restaurant, meaning a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals.

"Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deems compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available.

The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals.

In the event the primary business ceases operation, fails to operate as a bona fide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void.

**GOLDEN VILLA – 1360 EAST ANAHEIM STREET #205** 

On November 6, 2013, the Long Beach Police Department received a request to review an application for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit from Financial Management. Golden Villa applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit on February 19, 2013, and as a result of the Police Department's investigation, a denial recommendation was made. Mr. Plong withdrew his application, and for a six-month period, applied for Occasional Event Permits. The recent request was to determine if Golden Villa at 1360 East Anaheim Street #205 has abided by the conditions set forth on their Occasional Event Permits over the last five months.

Golden Villa is a restaurant that serves Asian food and is located on the second floor of a small shopping center on the southeast corner of Anaheim Street and Mahanna Avenue in the Mekong Center. The business is owned and operated by Austin V. Plong who purchased the Golden Villa from Sophie Khut, in August 2012. Mr. Plong was issued a Business License for a restaurant with alcohol on September 12, 2013. Mr. Plong applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit on February 19, 2013 requesting dancing by patrons and performers, live music by more than two performers, live and recorded amplified music, a disc jockey and karaoke from 10:00am until 12:00 midnight Monday through Thursday, 10:00am until 2:00am on Friday and 8:00am until 2:00am on Saturday and Sunday.

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation, and the crime analysis, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit, subject to the following twenty-five (25) conditions:

#### **CONDITIONS OF OPERATION**

The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.

- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted between the hours of 10:00 AM and 10:00 PM Sunday through Thursday nights, and between 10:00 AM and 12 Midnight Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor to remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition.
- 5) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept <u>closed at all times</u> during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 7) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
- 8) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM.
- All promoters and independent contractors must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation. The permitte shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.

- 11) If the permitee utilizes an independent third party event promoter to provide entertainment related services resulting in any public safety call for service, the City reserves the right to remove and/or restrict the use of independent third party promoters.
- The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion there of, into a dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with **regular dining** or **pre-planned banquet activities**. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d-oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 13) The permittee shall not require an admission or cover charge for entry to any event taking place at the establishment.
- This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals. The business must offer substantial sales of meals, during the normal meal hours that the business is open. Fast food, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a substantial meal. Normal meal hours are: Breakfast 6:00 AM 9:00 AM, Lunch 11:00 AM 2:00 PM, and dinner 6:00 PM 9:00 PM.

If the business does not open by 6:00 PM, complete and substantial meals shall be offered the entire time the business is open, or for a minimum of three hours. In the event the primary business ceases operations or fails to comply with this condition, the entertainment permit becomes null and void.

- The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot at all times. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for police service, of trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operations as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 17) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 18) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time, and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 19) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- Golden Villa, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at any time.
- 21) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment after 10:00 PM for the sole purposes of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver's license or identification card.
- 22) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City of Long Beach whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

- The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the Internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 25) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employee's proof of completion on file, and be available for inspection at any time.

The Planning Bureau of the Department of Development Services has the following comments:

A review of the permit history for 1360 E. Anaheim Street, Unit 205, indicates that one Conditional Use Permit Exemption (Case No. 1210-08) was approved for alcohol sales with meals only at an existing restaurant.

The subject property is located within the Community Commercial Pedestrian Oriented District (CCP). Within the CCP district, dancing by patrons is permitted as an accessory use to a restaurant. Based on the floor plans submitted for the previous application and the current application, there have been no significant changes made to the floor plan. No additional parking is required.

Planning Bureau recommends that the entertainment permit with dancing for "Golden Villa Restaurant" be approved.
