### FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 31616

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THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 31616 (this "Amendment") is made and entered, in duplicate, as of August 1, 2011, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on September 22, 2009, by and between JOHN BEAN TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION DBA JBT AEROTECH, a Delaware corporation ("Contractor"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Contract No. 31616 (the "Contract") whereby Contractor agreed to perform maintenance and associated services for baggage handling and conveyance systems at the Long Beach Airport ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Contract to reduce the Scope of Work thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Contract, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2.B of the Contract is hereby amended to add a pricing option for one (1) full-time technician to provide forty (40) hours of maintenance support per week, more particularly described in Exhibit "A-1" to this Amendment ("Pricing Scenario 3"). City selects Pricing Scenario 3 for year two of this Contract, and City shall have the option of selecting any of the Pricing Scenarios to be applicable during year three of this Contract at the end of year two of this Contract.
- 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions of the Contract are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect, including without limitation terms and conditions related to price and payment and Contract term.

#### SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Maintenance Services for the Baggage Handling and Conveyance systems. JBT offers fixed pricing to cover 100% Preventive Maintenance (PM) and Inventory Control Management for the Baggage Handling and Conveyance Systems. Manning for this proposal will be one (1) Full-Time Technician, forty (40) hours per week.

Please Note: Hours for Corrective Repairs and Emergency Cail-Outs are not included in the Preventive Maintenance (PM) price, and will be invoiced at actual based on the Emergency Call-Out Service Rates as listed in the existing contract.

Year-1 (April 1, 2011 - March 31, 2012) \$228,722.00

Year-2 (April 1, 2012 - March 31, 2013) \$239,468.00

Year-3 (April 1, 2013 – March 31, 2014) \$250,758.00

Our Proposal for wages for our Technician is in compliance with California Labor Code and General Prevailing Wage determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations. The craft selected for these services is "Elevator Constructor".

2. Tax Note. The Buyer is responsible for payment to the Seller of any sales/use or other similar type taxes imposed on this sale. Based on tax rates in effect on the date of this proposal, state and local sales/use tax at 9.75% must be added to material only.

Seller will accept a valid exemption certificate from the Buyer if applicable; however, if an exemption certificate previously accepted is not recognized by the government taxing authority involved, and Seller is required to pay the tax covered by such exemption certificate, Buyer agrees to promptly reimburse Seller for the taxes paid.

Because of possible changes and variations in the completion of the contract, the <u>actual tax</u> will be calculated pursuant to applicable state law and assessed upon completion of this project unless state law requires the tax to be collected on a periodic basis,

- 3. VALIDITY. These prices will remain valid for a period of sixty (60) days.
- 4. SCHEDULING. Contract Manning Requirements will be changed after receipt of a fully executed Change Order/Contract Amendment.
