

Terminal Area Improvement Project – Phase I

- Completed in 2012
 - Passenger Concourse
 - TSA Passenger Screening Facility
 - Parking Structure B



Phase II – Renovate, Rehabilitate, and Revitalize

Continue to enhance the travel experience:

- Renovate to simplify the pre-security check-in process;
- Rehabilitate the Historic Terminal's timeless beauty and restore original functionality;
 - Relocate mechanical functions from public view
 - Create community engagement and hospitality space
- Revitalize and streamline pedestrian and vehicular accessibility.




Airport Priorities


- Continues projects contemplated by Council certified FEIR 37-03 and Council allocation of 89,995 SF for terminal facilities;
- Advances the “8 by 28” Olympics Initiative;
- Accommodates existing activity;
- No impact to the general fund;
- No additional flights as a result of the project.




Existing Terminal Site Plan

Project Entitlements

- April 5, 2018 – Planning Commission approved Addendum to FEIR 37-03 and the Phase II Site Plan Review
- April 9, 2018 – Cultural Heritage Commission approved a Certificate of Appropriateness for renovation of the historic Long beach Airport Terminal Building

Terminal Area Space Allotment and FEIR 37-03 Approvals

City Council Approved EIR	97,545 sf
City Council Adjusted Space Allocation	89,995 sf
Terminal Area post Phase I	70,169 sf
Terminal Area post Phase II	89,929 sf

Council Action

- Design-Build Contract – \$65,259,490
- Initial funding – \$32,572,824
- Initial projects – Ticketing lobby, Consolidated Baggage Claim, TSA In-Line Baggage Screening Facility
- Funding Sources: Airport Cash, PFC, CFC, and TSA Grants
- Phased progression to maintain airline passenger operations
- Contract termination option available at any point
- Total project completion – 2021
