



PROCLAMATION

establishing the

Friendship City

relationship between the

CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, USA

and the

CITY OF ENSENADA, BAJA CALIFORNIA, MEXICO

In accordance with the authorization and approval expressed by the City of Long Beach, California, USA, and the City of Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico, it is proclaimed and declared that a "Friendship City" relationship between the two cities is hereby established for the following purposes:

- (1) to promote and expand the effective and mutually beneficial cooperation between the people of Long Beach and the people of Ensenada; and
- (2) to promote international goodwill, understanding, and expanded business relations between the two cities and their respective nations by the exchange of people, ideas, and information in a wide variety of economic, social, cultural, educational, municipal, environmental, professional, technical, youth, and other endeavors; and
- (3) to foster and encourage charitable, scientific, trade and commerce, literary and educational activities between the two cities.

This Friendship City relationship shall be officially established and shall become effective when this proclamation has been duly executed by the Mayor of Long Beach, California, USA, and the Mayor of Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico.
