FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 29282

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 29282 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 11, 2006 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on August 2, 2005, by and between TRAFFIC OPERATIONS, INC., a California corporation ("Contractor"), whose address is 216 Toby Way, Pomona, California 91767, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, pursuant to a "Notice Inviting Bids for the Annual Contract for Street Striping, Pavement and Curb Markings, and Traffic Signing in the City of Long Beach, California," dated June 10, 2005, and published by the City, bids were received, publicly opened and declared on the date specified in said Notice; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager accepted the bid of the Contractor; and WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager to enter a contract with Contractor for the work described in Plans & Specifications No. R-6682; and WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Agreement and in this First Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 4. of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "4. <u>TIME FOR CONTRACT</u>. Contractor shall commence work on September 15, 2005 and shall complete all work by September 14, 2006, subject to strikes, lockouts and events beyond the control of Contractor. The first extended term shall commence on September 15, 2006 and shall terminate on September 14, 2007. Time is of the essence hereunder. City will suffer damage if the work is not completed within the time stated, but those damages would be difficult or impractical to determine. So, Contractor shall pay to City, as liquidated damages, the amount stated in the Contract Documents."
