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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A STANDARD AGREEMENT,  
6 AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH THE STATE OF  
7 CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS  
8 AND THE BUREAU OF CANNABIS CONTROL, TO  
9 RECEIVE AND EXPEND STATE OF CALIFORNIA, EQUITY  
10 ACT GRANT FUNDING

12 WHEREAS, the members of the California Legislature have recognized the  
13 need for equity grant funding; and

14 WHEREAS, funding has been provided to the Bureau of Cannabis Control  
15 to provide grant funds to local governments pursuant to the Budget Act of 2019, Item  
16 1111-490 – Reappropriation; and

17 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach (the "City") has  
18 adopted or operates a local equity program for commercial cannabis activity; and

19 WHEREAS, the City has determined that it will use grant funds from the  
20 Bureau of Cannabis Control to assist local equity applicants and licensees through its  
21 local equity program for commercial cannabis activity as described in its application for  
22 grant funds;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
24 follows:

25 Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby  
26 authorized to execute on behalf of the City a standard agreement, including any  
27 extensions or amendments thereof and any subsequent contract with the State in relation  
28 thereto.

It is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California, Department of Consumer Affairs, Bureau of Cannabis Control disclaims responsibility for any such liability.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.


