3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH CONFIRMING, FOLLOWING
5 HEARING, THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE FOURTH
6 STREET PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA
7 ADVISORY COMMISSION, CONTINUING THE LEVY OF
8 ANNUAL ASSESSMENT AS SET FORTH IN SAID REPORT
9 AND SETTING FORTH OTHER RELATED MATTERS

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36533 of the California Streets and
12 Highways Code, the Fourth Street Parking and Business Improvement Area Advisory
13 Board has caused a Report to be prepared for October 1, 2008 through September 30,
14 2009 relating to the Fourth Street Parking and Business Improvement Area ("FSPBIA")
15 which is located generally in that section of the City of Long Beach generally bounded by
16 Cherry Avenue and Carroll Park North with frontage along Fourth Street ; and

17 WHEREAS, said Report contains, among other things, all matters required
18 to be included by the above cited Section 36533; and,

19 WHEREAS, on October 7, 2008, at 5:00 p.m., the City Council conducted a
20 public hearing relating to that Report in accordance with its Resolution of Intention No.

21 RES-08-0112, adopted September 16, 2008, at which public hearing all interested
22 persons were afforded a full opportunity to appear and be heard on all matters relating to
23 the Report; and,

24 WHEREAS, a majority protest not having been received, it is the City
25 Council's desire to confirm the Report as originally filed and impose and continue the levy
26 of the Annual Assessment as described in the Report;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

1 Section 1. A public hearing having been conducted on October 7, 2008,
2 at 5:00 p.m., and all persons having been afforded an opportunity to appear and be
3 heard, the City Council hereby confirms the Report of the Fourth Street Parking and
4 Business Improvement Area Advisory Board, previously filed and approved by Resolution
5 No. RES-08-0112, adopted September 16, 2008, as originally filed, and declares
6 that this resolution shall constitute the levy of the Assessment referred to in the Report for
7 October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009 as more specifically set forth in Exhibit "A".

8 Section 2. The City Council further confirms that the Advisory Board for
9 the FSPBIA shall consist of the Board of Directors of the Fourth Street Business
10 Association.


11 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
