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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 15.20.060
RELATING TO MAINTENANCE OF SEWERS

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.20.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.20.060 Maintenance.

All sewer laterals, industrial connection sewers, private sewage disposal systems and appurtenances thereto now existing or hereafter constructed shall be maintained by the owner of the property in a safe and sanitary condition and all devices or safeguards which are required by Chapters 15.04 through 15.28 and the rules, regulations and charges governing water and sewer service for the operation thereof shall be maintained in a good working order.

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Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.

All building sewers, sewer laterals, industrial connection sewers, private sewage disposal systems and appurtenances thereto now existing or hereafter constructed shall be maintained by the owner of the property in a safe and sanitary condition and all devices or safeguards which are required by Chapters 15.04 through 15.28 and the rules, regulations and charges governing water and sewer service for the operation thereof shall be maintained in a good working order. The above provisions notwithstanding, the water department shall maintain the house connection extending from the property line to the main line sewer within the public right of way.
