Subject: ABC License for 4709-4711 East 2nd Street, Super Mex Restaurants, Inc. dba SuperMex

I am submitting the following conditions for your consideration for an original application for an On-Sale General license for a bona fide eating place.

1. Sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 am and 12:00 midnight each day of the week. The patio hours 9:00 am to 10:00 pm, each day of the week.
2. The premises shall be equipped and maintained in good faith as a restaurant and shall possess, in operative condition, such convenience for cooking foods as stove, ovens, broilers, and other devices as well as pots, pans or containers which can be used for cooking or heating foods on the type of heating device employed.
3. The premises shall possess the necessary utensils, table service and condiment dispensers with which to serve meals to the public.
4. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Section 23038 of the Business and Professions Code and acknowledges the incidental, sporadic, or infrequent sales of meals or a mere offering of meals without actual sales of meals or a mere offering of meals without actual sales shall not be deemed sufficient to consider the premises in compliance with the aforementioned code section.
5. Food facilities must be maintained in a sanitary condition and the premises must be equipped with a proper amount of refrigeration for keeping food on the premises and be equipped with such other facilities are necessary to comply with all regulations of the local health department.
6. There shall be no bar or lounge area upon the licensed premises maintained for the purpose of sales, service or consumption of alcoholic beverages directly to patrons for consumption.
7. No pool or video games or coin-operated amusement devices maintained upon the premises.

8. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained upon the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the premises or in the patio dining area.
9. There shall be no live entertainment, amplified music or dancing permitted on the premises at any time.
10. The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
11. The subject alcoholic beverage license shall not be exchanged for a public premises type license nor operated as a public premises.
12. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control, as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 11-6-14 and ABC-253 dated 11-6-14.
13. Loitering is prohibited on or around these premises or this area under the control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 11-6-14 and ABC-253 dated 11-6-14.
14. Alcoholic beverages may be sold to and consumed by patrons in the patio area only while they are seated at tables and with the consumption of food..
15. The licensee(s) or an employee of the licensee(s) will be present in the patio at all times that alcoholic beverages are being served or consumed.
