SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34352

THIS SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34352 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 27, 2023, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on April 12, 2022, by and between UNITED STORM WATER, INC., a California corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 14000 E. Valley Boulevard, City of Industry, California 91746, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 34352 (the "Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide storm drain routine maintenance and repair in an annual amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Dollars (\$276,000) for a period of three (3) years, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement to add a one-time amount of Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$710,000) to cover the many emergency storm calls that took place December 2016 to February 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to July 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to the Agreement to add One Million Two Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Forty-Five Dollars (\$1,269,045) for the term expiring in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to July 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fifth Amendment to the Agreement to add One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for a total not to exceed amount of Four Million Seven Hundred and Four Thousand and Forty-Five Dollars (\$4,704,045), extend the term to April 30, 2022, and attach an updated rate sheet; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Sixth Amendment to extend the term

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to September 30, 2022, and attached an updated rate sheet;

WHEREAS the parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement to April 30, 2023, and attach an updated rate sheet,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "2. <u>TERM</u>. The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on August 1, 2016, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2023, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement, or unless the services or the Project is completed sooner."
- 2. The Rates in Exhibit "B-2" to the Sixth Amendment to the Agreement are hereby amended in accordance with Exhibit "B-3", attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
- 3. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 34352 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
