AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. C-6496, adopted July 5, 1988, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

13 Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the
14 City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long
15 Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor.
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


