3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH SUPPORTING THE LABOR
5 NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN COVANTA AND THE
6 INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL
7 WORKERS, LOCAL 11 ON BEHALF OF THE EMPLOYEES
8 OF THE SOUTHEAST RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY

10 WHEREAS, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers ("IBEW"),
11 Local 11 represents over twelve thousand (12,000) electricians, communications and
12 systems installers, transportation systems journeymen, civil service electricians,
13 apprentices, construction wiremen and construction electricians across Los Angeles
14 County; and

15 WHEREAS, during an election supervised by the National Labor Relations
16 Board, eighty percent (80%) of the employees of the Southeast Resource Recovery
17 Facility ("SERRF") voted in the affirmative to join IBEW, Local 11; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a strong record of standing with
19 working men and women who choose labor representation; and

20 WHEREAS, SERRF supports our public safety by safely destroying 17,000
21 pounds of narcotics each month; and

22 WHEREAS, SERRF, which recycles over 825 tons of metal each month
23 that would otherwise go to landfills, is an asset to the City of Long Beach;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
25 follows:

26 Section 1. The City of Long Beach along with the Mayor supports the
27 good faith negotiations between Covanta and the International Brotherhood of Electrical
