ORDINANCE NO. ORD-14-0016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 2.03.040
RELATING TO ORDER OF BUSINESS

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.03.040 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is
amended to read as follows:

2.03.040 Order of business.

A. The order of business of the City Council at all regular
meetings shall be as follows, unless otherwise waived by consent of the
Council:

1. Call to order by Mayor;
2. Roll call of the City Council by City Clerk;
3. Moment of silence;
4. Pledge of Allegiance;
5. Hearings;
6. Public Comment: The opportunity for members of the

public to address the City Council on matters of public business which are
not listed on the agenda but are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the
City Council, which shall be conducted in accordance with the following
rules:

a. Each person desiring to address the City
Council pursuant to this part of the order of business shall submit his or her
name and the subject matter in writing to the City Clerk prior to the

1 commencement of the Council meeting, and in no event later than the
2 conclusion of the presentation by the last person to speak under this part;

3 b. All addresses to the City Council under this part
4 shall be limited to three (3) minutes;

5 c. The total number of speakers under this part
6 shall be limited to the first ten (10) persons who have submitted their names
7 in writing to the City Clerk;

8 d. The total amount of time to be devoted to
9 addresses under this part shall not exceed thirty (30) minutes unless said
10 limit on the total amount of time is waived by consent of the City Council.

11 7. Consent calendar:

12 a. Approval of the minutes of previous meeting(s).

13 8. Unfinished business;

14 9. Regular agenda;

15 10. Ordinance(s);

16 11. New business:

17 a. Announcements.

18 12. Public Comment: The opportunity for those members
19 of the public to address the City Council on nonagenda items who have not
20 already addressed the City Council on nonagenda items at the same
21 meeting;

22 13. Adjournment. In the event the City Council desires to
23 adjourn to a certain hour on another day, a motion shall be made either
24 prior to or as part of the regular motion to adjourn indicating the hour and
25 date to which the meeting is adjourned.

26 B. The rules of parliamentary practice contained in "Robert's
27 Rules Of Order" shall govern the Council where applicable and not
28 otherwise inconsistent with any provision of this Code.


