A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020 FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING AND/OR ELECTING CANDIDATES FOR THREE (3) CITY COUNCIL OFFICES, COUNCIL DISTRICT NUMBERS 2, 6, AND 8; NOMINATING AND/OR ELECTING CANDIDATES FOR TWO (2) LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD MEMBERS, DISTRICT NUMBERS 2 AND 4; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOTS TO BE USED AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, THE NAMES OF THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN NOMINATED IN THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION TO THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE BEEN ELECTED AT THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-19-0159, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for three (3) City Council Offices, namely for the Second, Sixth and Eighth Districts; and

WHEREAS, the election was held in the City of Long Beach on that day;
and

1 WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, duly
2 canvassed the returns of the election and has transmitted the results to the City Clerk;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does
4 resolve, determine, order and declare as follows:

5 Section 1. That the Primary Nominating Election for the purpose of
6 nominating and/or electing candidates as required by law for three (3) Members of the
7 City Council, was duly held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, and the votes cast, including the
8 Vote by Mail ballots issued in connection with the election which were returned at the
9 time and in the form and manner required by law were all duly and regularly canvassed.
10 That the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk has duly canvassed the
11 returns of the election and filed the Certificate of Canvass with the City Council and from
12 that certification the City Council finds that the total number of votes cast in each district,
13 the total number of votes cast in each of the respective election precincts established for
14 the election, the number of votes cast for each candidate in each precinct and the total
15 number of votes for each candidate, are as provided in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and
16 made a part of this resolution.
