

RESOLUTION NO. RES-23-0125

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS TO PROVIDE JAIL FOOD SERVICES, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$146,128

WHEREAS, City Council approval is requested to enter into a contract with the County of Los Angeles through the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department ("LASD") for jail food services to be provided to individuals booked at the City of Long Beach's jail facility; and

WHEREAS, the scope of services in the agreement includes providing and delivering pre-packaged prepared meals for use in the City jail facility in accordance with the nutritional, caloric, food preparation, and quality requirements mandated by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Police Department ("LBPD") recommends LASD for jail food services based on factors including cooperation with common practices and procedures among law enforcement agencies, proximity and availability to the food services at the Los Angeles County Courthouse, which are provided by LASD in emergency situations, menu selection variety, and extensive experience in providing food services to inmates; and

WHEREAS, LBPD researched other food service options and concluded that LASD was the best value for the City with their lowest cost per meal rate and their level of service that satisfies all established guidelines outlined by the Board of State and

1 Community Corrections; and

2 WHEREAS, LASD has proven to be efficient in providing jail food services
3 to the City for several years and after a thorough review, it was determined that LASD
4 meets and/or exceeds the City's requirements; and

5 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
6 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary
7 expenditure of public funds;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
9 follows:

10 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
11 herein.

12 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract and
13 any subsequent amendments with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to
14 provide jail food services, in a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Six
15 Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$146,128), for a period of five (5) years,
16 with the option to renew for three (3) additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the
17 City Manager.

18 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
19 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
