

Subject: 5313 East 2nd Street, dba Boubouffe Grille, ABC License *R-20*

I am submitting the following conditions for your consideration for an original application of an On-Sale Beer and Wine license for a bonafide eating place.

1. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
2. The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or bottles into the outside dumpsters between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.
3. There shall be no exterior advertising promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages.
4. Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible beyond 50 feet from the property line of the premises.
5. The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside the establishment at all times.
6. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 11:30 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday.
7. The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the gross sales of food during the same period. The licensee shall at all times maintain records which reflect separately the gross sales of food and the gross sales of alcoholic beverages of the licensed business. Said records shall be kept no less frequently than on a quarterly basis and shall be made available to the Department on demand.
8. There shall be no bar or lounge area upon the licensed premises maintained for the purpose of sales, service or consumption of alcoholic beverages directly to patrons for consumption.
9. At all times when the premises are open for business the sale of alcoholic beverages shall be made only in conjunction with the sale of food to the person ordering the beverage.

10. The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
11. No "happy hour" type of reduced price alcoholic beverage promotion shall be allowed.
12. There shall be no pool or billiard tables, amusement machines or video game devices and a limit of one (1) television in the premises at any time.
13. No live entertainment or dancing, no disc jockey and no amplified music or stereo systems shall be permitted on the premises at any time.
14. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted in the patio area only between the hours of 10 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. daily.
