

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
Diana Joy Garafano has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of her employment with the City of Long Beach.


Michael Todd Youngblood has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach.

The Economic Development and Finance Committee, on June 1, 2004, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Michael Todd Youngblood, based upon a 4 1/2 percent permanent disability rating, or \$1,890.00; with a provision for total temporary disability in the amount of \$13,110.00; and with a provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
