

RESOLUTION NO. RES-20-0012

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY
6 AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
7 INTERGOVERNMENTAL TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT
8 CENTER, DBA GOVERNMENT TRAINING AGENCY
9 WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR PEACE
10 OFFICER STANDARDS TRAINING (POST) CERTIFIED
11 COURSES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.

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13 WHEREAS, training standards for California law enforcement personnel are
14 set by the State of California's Commission on Peace Officer Standards Training (POST);
15 and

16 WHEREAS, POST hosts the Robert Presley Institute of Criminal
17 Investigation (ICI) core course which is designed to enhance the effectiveness of criminal
18 investigators (detectives) to successfully conduct comprehensive criminal investigations;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, in FY17 and FY18, the Long Beach Police Department's
21 (LBPD) Investigations Bureau experienced a high number of turnover among seasoned
22 detectives due to retirements therefore the Bureau is required to train many new
23 detectives and detective supervisors.; and

24 WHEREAS, in previous years, LBPD has funded the training and travel
25 costs to send individual detectives to attend the ICI training in Northern California; and

26 WHEREAS, through coordination and approval with POST, LBPD
27 collaborated with Southern California Intergovernmental Training and Development
28 Center doing business as Government Training Agency, an agency that hosts a two-

1 week ICI course in a conference center in Irvine to 30 LBPD detectives and sergeants,
2 eliminating the need for overnight travel expenses.

3 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
4 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary
5 expenditure of public funds;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
9 herein.

10 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract and
11 any amendments thereto with Southern California Intergovernmental Training and
12 Development Center doing business as Government Training Agency for the for Peace
13 Officer Standards Training certified courses in an annual amount not to exceed One
14 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars \$150,000, for a period of two years, with the option to
15 renew for three additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager.

16 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
17 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
