

RESOLUTION NO. RES-13-0007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH RETRACTING IMPLEMENTATION
OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4)
PURSUANT TO SECTION 20691 AS TO PAYING AND
REPORTING THE VALUE OF EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER
CONTRIBUTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY
THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS
AND AEROSPACE WORKERS TO THE CALIFORNIA
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Government Code Section 20691;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement
which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the
employer, and reported as special compensation; and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in negotiations with the International
Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers and the parties have agreed to amend
the Memorandum of Understanding with respect to payment and reporting of the value of
employer paid member contributions (EPMC); and

WHEREAS, current members of the International Association of Machinists
and Aerospace Workers have agreed to pay the full member contribution; and

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section of
the Government Code is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of
a resolution giving notice of its intention to cease paying and reporting the value of
Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the

group or class identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Effective as of January 26, 2013, the governing body of the City of Long Beach shall retract its previous implementation of Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691 as to paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) for miscellaneous employees represented by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers. In so doing, the City will pay zero percent (0%) and report the same percent (0%) and the member will pay one hundred percent (100%) of the normal member contribution which is currently eight percent (8%) of the member's compensation.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
