RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys, and walkways in Long Beach in connection with the 2019 Formula Drift Pro Championship. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The 14th Annual Formula Drift Pro Championship will be held in Long Beach from April 5 through 6, 2019. This event will attract over 25,000 people to the City. To allow for the staging of this event, a Resolution has been prepared that provides for the temporary closure of a portion of Shoreline Drive between Ocean Boulevard and Shoreline Village Drive, and various adjacent streets. This area will be used as part of the venue for the festival, which will also be held on the Marina Green and at Rainbow Lagoon Park. Additional space is required for the safety of event attendees due to projected attendance figures.

Access to Shoreline Marina and Shoreline Village will be via Shoreline Village Drive. Directional signage will be provided to clearly direct traffic to these areas. The appropriate City departments have reviewed the requested closure plans.

Traffic management and signage plans will be shared with the public through various media outlets.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard F. Anthony on November 5, 2018 and by Budget Analysis Officer Julissa José-Murray on November 2, 2018.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on January 22, 2019, to expedite the execution of the Resolution in a timely manner.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal or local job impact associated with this recommendation.

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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS, AND WALKWAYS IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 2019 FORMULA DRIFT PRO CHAMPIONSHIP

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the temporary closing of the streets, described herein, is necessary for the safety and protection of the participants and spectators in the 2019 Formula Drift Pro Championship to be held from April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019.

Section 2. For the conduct of the 2019 Formula Drift Pro Championship, the following streets, alleys, and walkways are hereby temporarily closed for the periods stated:

A. On April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to eastern end of Seaside Way, Linden Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Locust Avenue to Collins Way, Atlantic Way from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Hart Place to eastern end, Linden Avenue, northbound and southbound from Shoreline Drive to Marina Parking lot, and Locust Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way.

B. On April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Shoreline Drive westbound from Ocean Boulevard and Alamitos intersection to Shoreline Village Drive.

C. On April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00

1 p.m., Shoreline Drive eastbound from Shoreline Village Drive to Ocean
2 Boulevard and Alamitos intersection.

3 D. On April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
4 p.m., walkway off of Seaside Way from Hart Place to the east end of
5 Seaside Way.

6 Section 3. The temporary closing of the above streets, alleys, and
7 walkways, for the times herein provided is necessary for the safety and protection of the
8 participants and spectators in the 2019 Formula Drift Pro Championship and qualifying
9 events to be held from April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019, utilizing the streets described
10 herein.

11 Section 4. For the period April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00
12 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.A. are hereby
13 withdrawn and removed from public use.

14 Section 5. For the period April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00
15 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.B. are hereby
16 withdrawn and removed from public use.

17 Section 6. For the period April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00
18 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.C. are hereby
19 withdrawn and removed from public use.

20 Section 7. For the period April 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 from 7:00
21 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.D. are hereby
22 withdrawn and removed from public use.

23 Section 8. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed
24 to post notices of the intent to temporarily reduce lanes, close the streets, alleys,
25 walkways described in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 above at least twenty-four (24) hours
26 prior to the closure thereof.

27 Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
28 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
