#### Change happens when people recognize:


- 1. Why the change is needed

#### GDP gains with racial equity • Los Angeles-Long Beach-Santa Ana, CA Metro Area




Actual GDP and estimated GDP with racial equity in income (billions): Los Angeles-Long Beach-Santa Ana, CA Metro Area, 2015

Equality provides the same thing for everyone. This only works when people start from the same place, history and set of circumstances.


#### Equity = Justice






