a. A Charter amendment to create a "Rainy Day" reserve in the City's budget. In any given year when revenue growth is in excess of five (5) percent over the previous year, 50 percent

of the excess will be placed into a reserve. During lean fiscal times, the City would be able to withdraw up to 50 percent of the reserve funds in a given year, but no more than the revenue decline from the previous year. The reserve would be capped at 40 percent of General Fund.
