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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ZOLL  
6 MEDICAL CORPORATION, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR  
7 BIDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF 12-LEAD  
8 ELECTROCARDIOGRAM DEFIBRILLATOR UNITS,  
9 BATTERIES AND ACCESSORIES IN AN ANNUAL  
10 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$113,410  
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12 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Fire Department currently utilizes 12-lead  
13 electrocardiogram units supplied by Zoll Medical Corporation to provide emergency  
14 medical services; and

15 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Fire Department requires additional units,  
16 parts and accessories compatible with its current models and monitors, on which all Long  
17 Beach paramedics have been trained; and

18 WHEREAS, the additional units will streamline the identification and  
19 treatment of cardiac patients in order to improve their care; and

20 WHEREAS, Zoll Medical Corporation does not use regional distributors and  
21 is the sole manufacturer and source for its products; and

22 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising  
23 for bids for 12-lead electrocardiogram defibrillator units, parts and accessories, and to do  
24 so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public  
25 funds;

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NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract, without advertising for bids, with Zoll Medical Corporation for the purchase of 12-lead electrocardiogram defibrillator units, batteries and accessories for a period of one (1) year in an amount not to exceed \$113,410 annually, with the option of renewing the agreement for three (3) additional one-year periods at the discretion of the City Manager or his or her designee. If the sole source status of Zoll Medical Corporation changes, the City shall publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
