Within the meaning of this Chapter, holidays are as defined in California Government Code, Section 6700, as it may be amended from time to timeshall be defined as follows:

- 1. January 1, known as "New Year's Day";
- 2. The third Monday in January, known as "Dr. Martin Luther King Day";
- 3. The third Monday in February, known as "Presidents Day";
- 4. The last Monday in May, known as "Memorial Day";
- 5. July 4, known as "Independence Day";
- 6. The first Monday in September, known as "Labor Day";
- Thanksgiving Day;
- 8. The day after Thanksgiving Day; and
- 9. December 25, known as "Christmas Day".

10.28.050 - Payment for metered parking space.

A. No person shall park, stand, or stop any vehicle in any metered parking space during a period for which a parking time limit is applicable to the space without making payment for the use of such space as posted. The provisions of this Section shall not be applicable on holidays as defined in Section 10.02.040 of this Code or during those hours when a parking time limitation is not imposed, nor shall it apply to a vehicle displaying a valid veteran's license plate.

Section 2. Subsection 10.28.050.A. of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

10.28.050 Payment for metered parking space.

A. No person shall park, stand, or stop any vehicle in any metered parking space during a period for which a parking time limit is applicable to the space without making payment for the use of such space as posted. The provisions of this Section shall not be applicable on holidays as defined in Section 10.02.040 of this Code or during those hours when a parking time limitation is not imposed, nor shall it apply to a vehicle displaying a valid veteran's license plate.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
