RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit four Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay 1) \$42,840.00, 2) \$42,840.00, 3) \$6,957.50, and 4) \$149,080.98 with a life pension thereafter of \$105.48 per week in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for Gary Richens.

DISCUSSION:

Gary Richens has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on August 8, 2014, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of four Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Gary Richens, based upon 1) a 48 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, 2) a 48 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, 3) a 10 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 4) a 73 percent disability rating with further provision for a life pension at the rate of \$105.48 per week after the permanent disability has been paid, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
