



## **New Permanent Belmont Aquatics Facility**

Separate multi-purpose pool, with an 80% surface area over deep water component and a 20% surface area over shallow water component



- (1) ADVANTAGE OVER 3-POOL CONCEPT.
  Solves weller tamperature issues by allowing pool to be heated to temperature comfortable for divers, small children in lessons, and therpay users. Eliminates the need for a third heating and pump system
- (2) Moveable Bulkhead to divide shallow area for swim lessons, therapy and shallow-water serobics from deep water. Bulkhead can remain flush to end wall when those activities are not taking place. Bulkhead does not need to be greater in width than 6°-12° as it will not be walked on, nor used for turns during connections.
- (3) Width to be determined, preferably 25 yards.
