RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the application of The Wine Beach, LLC, dba The Wine Beach, for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license, at 5351 Second Street; submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC; and, direct the City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit Exception (CUPEX) is granted. (District 3)

DISCUSSION

It is City Council policy to review applications for ABC licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control received the above application on March 25, 2021. The applicant is still in the planning stages and has not yet received a CUPEX. Provided the Planning Commission approves the CUPEX, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest. City Council action is requested on May 11, 2021, to respond to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control by the May 14, 2021 due date.
