Robert E. Shannon Attorney of Long Beach A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT ON ALAMITOS AVENUE BETWEEN SEVENTH STREET AND PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, a public hearing was called for October 17, 2006, at the hour of 5:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber on the Plaza Level of the City Hall, 333 West Ocean Boulevard, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to ascertain whether it is in the general public interest to replace utility poles, overhead wires and associated structures with the underground installation of wires and facilities used for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service on Alamitos Avenue between Seventh Street and Pacific Coast Highway; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners, as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that it is in the general public interest to replace utility poles, overhead wires and associated structures, with the underground installation of wires and facilities used for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service on Alamitos Avenue between Seventh Street and Pacific Coast Highway and hereby establishes it as Underground Utility District No. 41.

Sec. 2. All poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures shall
be removed and underground installations made in said underground utility district within
the following times:
(a) Underground installation by utility companies and reconnections no
later than December 30, 2010, and
(b) Domoval of polos, everbood wires and other appointed everboos

- (b) Removal of poles, overhead wires and other associated overhead structures not later than December 30, 2010.
- Sec. 3. The utility companies shall pay all costs to provide no more than 100 feet of the property owner's underground service lateral, and to provide certain facility changes authorized under Section 15.48.090 of the municipal code.
- Sec. 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to mail a copy of this resolution to all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within the district within ten days after adoption of this resolution.
- Sec. 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
