A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING AN AGREEMENT TO AMEND THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS AND AEROSPACE WORKERS; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SUCH AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach (“City”) desires to amend the 2019-2023 IAMAW Memorandum of Understanding - Appendix C: HOURLY SKILL PAYS (GENERAL), to include a skill pay for Special Equipment Operator at \$2.00 per hour and Special Equipment Coordinator at \$3.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2023, in accordance with California Government Code Section 3505, the Harbor Department met and conferred with the IAMAW regarding the Harbor Department’s Security Division Boat and Drone Programs, to include Special Equipment Operator and Special Equipment Coordinator compensations; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the MOU language to reflect this change in order for it to be considered as special compensation and reportable to CalPERS;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The agreement to amend the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Long Beach and the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, incorporated by reference in this resolution, is hereby authorized and approved.

6 requested to cooperate fully with the City Manager in order to cause the required  
7 documents to be prepared as required by law and brought before the appropriate bodies.

8 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
9 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
