AGENDA ITEM: Update on the first TEDxSoCal Conference, Saturday,

July 16, 2011 at the Center Theatre in Long Beach

This agenda item provides an update on the progress of Long Beach hosting a TEDx conference – TEDxSoCal - in Long Beach on Saturday, July 16, 2011.

BACKGROUND:

On March 2, 2010, the City Council approved the recommendation to obtain a TEDx Long Beach license from Technology, Entertainment & Design (TED) organization as the first step in planning and holding an annual TEDx Long Beach event.

TEDx is an independently organized TED event organized and hosted at the local level by an individual, organization or institution. Through licensing, TED encourages local events that maintain the spirit of TED itself: cross-disciplinary, "focused on the power of ideas to change attitudes, lives and ultimately, the world."

On August 25, 2010, TED issued a license to Sylvia Earle, American Oceanographer and TED 2009 Prize Winner, to host a TEDx conference in Long

Beach. Since TED has been hosted in Long Beach since 2009, the TEDxLongBeach was renamed TEDxSoCal.

TEDxSoCal is a public, full-day conference on Saturday, July 16, 2011 at the International Center Theatre (where TED University is held during the annual TED conference). Organized along the theme of "Thriving," participants will have the opportunity to watch and listen to live speakers, pre-recorded TEDTalks and performances focused on the topics of well-being, creative cultures, sustainability and lifelong learning. Steve Goodling, President and CEO of the Long Beach Convention and Visitors Bureau will be the Master of Ceremonies.

Tickets will go on sale Friday, May 13th. Tickets will be \$40 for adults and \$20 for students. The link to purchase tickets will be made available on the website: www.tedxsocal.org. Tickets are limited.
