### Approach to Budget Reductions:

- Begin to stabilize police staffing levels by holding an academy in FY 13
- To facilitate ongoing funding for these academy recruits, roughly half of any FY 14 and FY 15 Police Department reductions is expected to come from reductions in nonsworn costs
- Maintain patrol calls for service as the highest priority, reducing specialized units and support functions
