Due to the over concentration of ABC licenses, high crime, residences within 100 feet and a public park within 600 feet, I request that the attached conditions be included with the ABC license.

The proprietor of the restaurant has been contacted and agrees to the conditions.

**Requested Alcoholic Beverage License Conditions**  
**An Original Application for**

**at 245 Pine Avenue, Suite 190**

The location is in the Downtown Dinning and Entertainment District. Due to being in a high crime reporting distinct, having an over concentration of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) licenses in police reporting district 082, residences within 100 feet and a public park within 600 feet, it is requested that the following conditions be applied:

1. The premise shall be maintained as a bona fide eating establishment and shall provide a menu containing an assortment of foods normally offered in such restaurants.
2. The quarterly gross sales of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the gross sales of food during the same period.
3. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee, not licensed by ABC for such sales.
4. All beverages offered for sale at the premises shall be displayed and available for convenient inspection and purchase within the premises by the general public.
5. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premise over which they have control.
6. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
7. To prevent loitering and other criminal activities exterior payphones are prohibited.
8. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent loitering of persons about the premises.
9. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained on the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the premises.
10. Licensee shall not offer or permit or provide any type of live entertainment except as allowed by a valid Entertainment Permit issued by the City of Long Beach.
