3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IN SUPPORT OF THE LONG
5 BEACH COLLEGE PROMISE

7 WHEREAS, the future of Long Beach is co-dependent upon the
8 effectiveness of its public educational partners in developing a well-educated workforce
9 and engaged citizenry to sustain and advance the economy of the City and surrounding
10 region; and

11 WHEREAS, the Long Beach education community has adopted as part of
12 its mission the responsibility to prepare its students for successful careers and productive
13 lives; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2008, the Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD), the
15 Long Beach Community College District (LBCCD), and California State University, Long
16 Beach (CSULB) have created a partnership to make higher education an attainable goal
17 for every student; and

18 WHEREAS, the Long Beach College Promise provides access to a college
19 education and a quality college credential to every student in the Long Beach Unified
20 School District; and

21 WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Council supports the Long Beach College
22 Promise as an expression of its profound respect and admiration of the accomplishments
23 of the LBUSD, LBCCD and CSULB; and

24 WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Council desires to partner on the Long
25 Beach College Promise by working together with the LBUSD, LBCCD and CSULB on the
26 activities that comprise the Long Beach College Promise, such as increasing the number
27 of students enrolled in quality pre-school programs; assisting the LBUSD in providing
28 quality worked based learning activities to high school students; and collaborate with

5 Section 1. That it strongly supports the Long Beach College Promise.


6 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
