

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0042

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT, AND ANY  
6 AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH LONG BEACH  
7 MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER, WITHOUT ADVERTISING  
8 FOR BIDS, FOR TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT  
9 SERVICES TO PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS, IN A TOTAL  
10 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000 FOR THE PERIOD  
11 ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021

13 WHEREAS, the Patient Care Assistant (PCA) Program provides  
14 customized training that focuses on developing transferable computer, clinical, and  
15 customer services skills essential for employment in the healthcare industry; and

16 WHEREAS, the PCA Program will serve 100 eligible participants and each  
17 participant will complete eight (8) weeks of classroom and clinical training; and

18 WHEREAS, Pacific Gateway will provide overall project management and  
19 oversight and prescreening for suitability; and

20 WHEREAS, Long Beach Memorial Medical Center (LBMMC) will hire and  
21 provide full-time employment for all participants upon successfully completing the training  
22 program and providing support for employee retention; and

23 WHEREAS, Pacific Gateway has partnered with LBMMC for over ten (10)  
24 years providing customized training cohorts to residents and enrolled participants in the  
25 local community; and

26 WHEREAS, LBMMC has trained over eight hundred (800) participants,  
27 which resulted in approximately the direct employment of six hundred (600) participants;  
28 and

1                   WHEREAS, no other medical facility in the Long Beach area provides  
2 customized cohort training for PCA and direct employment upon successful completion of  
3 training. In addition, with the increase in COVID-19 health needs, an increase of trained  
4 healthcare workers is needed; and

5                   WHEREAS, LBMHC is the sole vendor capable of assisting Pacific  
6 Gateway with timely and knowledgeable facilitation of training and the direct employment  
7 of residents and enrolled participants in the City; AND

8                   WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising  
9 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary  
10 expenditure of public funds;

11                   NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
12 follows:

13                   Section 1.    The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
14 herein.

15                   Section 2.    The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract,  
16 with Long Beach Memorial Medical Center for training and employment services to  
17 program participants, in a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars  
18 (\$200,000), for the period ending December 31, 2021.

19                   Section 3.    This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
20 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
