#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a resolution setting apart and dedicating for public street purposes portions of City-owned property, and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute easement deeds to be granted to Southern California Edison for aerial purposes and pole installations and relocations, all located at and/or near the intersections of Walnut Avenue, 20th Street and Alamitos Avenue. (District 6)

## **DISCUSSION:**

The City of Long Beach is in the process of reconfiguring the intersection where 20<sup>th</sup> Street meets Walnut Avenue and Alamitos Avenue, in order to improve the safety of students that attend nearby schools. The street reconfiguration will require relocation of Southern California Edison poles and installation of overhead electrical supply and communications systems, as well as the dedication of approximately 1,673 square feet of City property located at the northeast corner of Walnut Avenue and Alamitos Avenue, as shown on Exhibit A, and approximately 90 square feet of City property at the southwest corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Alamitos Avenue, as shown on Exhibit B.

In addition, in order to relocate poles and wires, it is necessary to grant to Southern California Edison a 10-foot wide easement for overhead electrical supply and communication systems at the intersections of Walnut Avenue, 20<sup>th</sup> Street, and Alamitos Avenue, as shown on Exhibit C, and a 10-foot wide easement for overhead electrical supply and communications systems on the southwest corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Alamitos Avenue, as shown on Exhibit D.

In conformance with the California Environmental Quality Act, Categorical Exemption No. CE 132-11 was issued for this project.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Linda Vu on February 7, 2013 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on April 5, 2013.

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# TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is not time critical.

# FISCAL IMPACT

The City's required document processing fees totaling \$6,140 will be paid from the project budget. Sufficient project funds are budgeted in the Capital Projects Fund (CP) in the Department of Public Works (PW). Approval of this matter could potentially have a positive impact on local jobs.

Adopt recommendation.






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#### RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE LONG BEACH SETTING APART AND **PURPOSES** FOR **PUBLIC** STREET DEDICATING PORTIONS OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT AND/OR NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF WALNUT AVENUE. 20TH STREET AND ALAMITOS AVENUE IN COUNTY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH. OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is in the process of reconfiguring the intersection where 20<sup>th</sup> Street meets Walnut Avenue and Alamitos Avenue, in order to improve the safety of students that attend nearby schools; and

WHEREAS, the street reconfiguration will require relocation of Southern California Edison poles, and installation of overhead electrical supply and communications systems, as well as the dedication of approximately 1,673 square feet of City property at the northeast corner of Walnut Avenue and Alamitos Avenue and approximately 90 square feet of City property at the southwest corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Alamitos Avenue; and

WHEREAS, in order to widen the street located at and near the intersection of Walnut Avenue, 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Alamitos Avenue, it is appropriate at this time to declare this area as additional public street;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the real property hereinafter described is hereby set apart and dedicated for public street purposes. Said real property is located in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on the attached

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Exhibit "A" and is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Lot 120 of the American Colony Tract, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map filed in Book 19, Pages 89 and 90, of Miscellaneous Records in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Northwesterly right of way line of Alamitos Avenue, 60 feet wide, as shown on a Record of Survey filed in Book 188, Pages 3 through 6, inclusive, of Records of Survey and the Southwesterly line of 20<sup>th</sup> Street, 50 feet wide, as shown on said Record of Survey; thence along the Northwesterly right of way line of said Alamitos Avenue, South 53°12'00" West 99.52 feet to the point of intersection of said line with the East right of way line of Walnut Avenue, 60 feet wide, as shown on said Record of Survey; Thence along said East right of way line North 00°00'13" East 57.99 feet to a point; Thence leaving said East right of way line South 45°04'46" East 14.65 feet; Thence North 89°54'45" East 21.90 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concave North having a radius of 95.00 feet; Thence Easterly and Northeasterly along said curve through a central angle of 29°31'26" a distance of 48.95 feet to a point on the Southwesterly line of said 20<sup>th</sup> Street, a radial line to said point bears South 29°36'42" East; Thence along said Southwesterly right of way line, being nontangent to last described curve, South 52°19'20" East 0.77 fee to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described parcel of land contains 1,673 square feet, more or less.

Section 2. That the real property hereinafter described is hereby set apart and dedicated for public street purposes. Said real property is located in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on the attached Exhibit "B" and is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Parcel 2, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles,

State of California, as per of Parcel Map No. 24543, filed in Book 276, Pages 45 through 47, inclusive, of Parcel Maps in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the centerline intersection of Alamitos Avenue, 60 feet wide, and 20<sup>th</sup> Street, 50 feet wide, as shown on a Record of Survey filed in Book 188, Pages 3 through 6, inclusive, of Records of Survey; Thence along the centerline of said Alamitos Avenue, South 52°19'20" East 41.19 feet to a point; Thence leaving said centerline, at right angles, South 37°40'40" West 15.00 feet to a point on the Southwesterly right of way line of said 20<sup>th</sup> Street and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; Thence along said Southwesterly right of way line North 52°19'20" West 14.22 feet to the intersection of said Southwesterly right of way line with the Southeasterly right of way line of said Alamitos Avenue; Thence along said Southeasterly right of way line South 53°12'00" West 13.09 feet; Thence leaving said Southeasterly right of way, South 87°45'35" East 21.75 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described parcel of land contains 90 square feet, more or less.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall forward, without delay, certified copies of this Resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles; the State Board of Equalization, Sacramento, California; and to the Recorder of said Los Angeles County for recordation.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
