WHEREAS, the California Labor Code §§ 1720-1781 requires contractors on public works projects to pay their workers based on the prevailing wage rates which are established by the Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR"), to keep accurate payroll records, and to employ registered apprentices; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has applied for and has been granted grant funds under Proposition 84, the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 ("Proposition 84"); and

WHEREAS the provisions of Proposition 84 require the establishment of a Labor Compliance Program to monitor and enforce prevailing wage requirements on projects using Proposition 84 funding; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a Labor Compliance Manual, which encompasses the Labor Compliance Program for all covered projects; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to submit an application for approval of its Labor Compliance Program to the DIR in order to implement its Labor Compliance Program; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Proposition 84 allow the City to utilize the services of third party labor compliance consulting firms to assist with the provision of
