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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT
6 WITH GOVCONNECTION, INC. DBA CONNECTION FOR
7 DATA CENTER SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT,
8 TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT, AND USER
9 DEVICES, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS
10 AFFORDED TO REGIONAL 4 EDUCATION SERVICE
11 CENTER THROUGH THE NATIONAL
12 INTERGOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING ALLIANCE – THE
13 COOPERATIVE PURCHASING NETWORK

15 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits
16 the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise,
17 without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with
18 other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

19 WHEREAS, the City desires data center systems equipment,
20 telecommunications equipment, and user devices; and

21 WHEREAS, Region 4 Education Service Center through National
22 Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance - The Cooperative Purchasing Network has a
23 contract with GovConnection, Inc. dba Connection for technology and interactive
24 whiteboard products and services, Contract No. R160202 ("TCPN Contract"); and

25 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the TCPN Contract will facilitate
26 timely acquisition of the data center systems equipment, telecommunications equipment,
27 and user devices as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

28 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the

1 TCPN Contract considerably more funds would be required;

2 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
3 follows:

4 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
5 an agreement with GovConnection, Inc. dba Connection to furnish, deliver and install
6 data center systems equipment, telecommunications equipment, and user devices, of the
7 same kind identified in the TCPN Contract in an amount not to exceed Eleven Million Two
8 Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$11,222,500) for the first year;
9 thereafter, in an annual amount not to exceed Two Million Eight Hundred Sixty-Six
10 Thousand Dollars (\$2,866,00), for ongoing lifecycle replacement of equipment and new
11 incremental technology growth, until the current contract expires on June 31, 2019, with
12 the option to renew for as long as the TCPN Contract is in effect, as needed.

13 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
14 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
