RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to receive supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing; adopt an urgency ordinance extending for six months a temporary limitation (moratorium) of construction and development activities in the Rancho Estates (PD-11) area; and declare ordinance read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of City Council for final reading. (District 5)

Recommendation to receive supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing; adopt an urgency ordinance extending for six months a temporary limitation (moratorium) of construction and development activities in the Los Cerritos area; and declare ordinance read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of City Council for final reading. (District 8)

DISCUSSION

On October 16, 2007, City Council adopted a one-year moratorium ordinance to prohibit construction of second story additions and the demolition of any residential structures in the Rancho Estates area (Exhibit A) (Ordinance 07-0048). In addition, Council adopted a moratorium to prohibit the construction of fences on corner lots within the side-yard setback area in the Los Cerritos area (Exhibit B) (Ordinance 07-0049). Both of these moratoriums expired on October 16, 2008. In order to complete preparation of proposed amendments to the Zoning Regulations and review recommendations with the community, staff is requesting a six-month extension to April 14, 2009.

In the Rancho Estates area, community meetings were held and a survey conducted. Based on the survey results and neighborhood input, staff is in the process of drafting a proposed amendment to Rancho Estates Planned Development Ordinance (PD-11) addressing design guidelines, fence location revisions and standards for additions. The changes will be presented at a community meeting in November. Following community review, the recommendations will be forwarded to Planning Commission and City Council during the first quarter of 2009.

With regard to the Los Cerritos area, staff has had discussions and continues to work with the Los Cerritos Improvement Association regarding Code changes for construction of fences in the street side-yard setback. The proposed recommendation will focus on changes to the location of fences in the street side-yard setback area. It is anticipated this will be ready for Council consideration in March 2009.

This letter was reviewed by Assistant City Attorney Michael Mais on October 21, 2008 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on October 24, 2008.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on November 18 as the Interim Ordinances have lapsed.


FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this recommendation.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Approve recommendation.

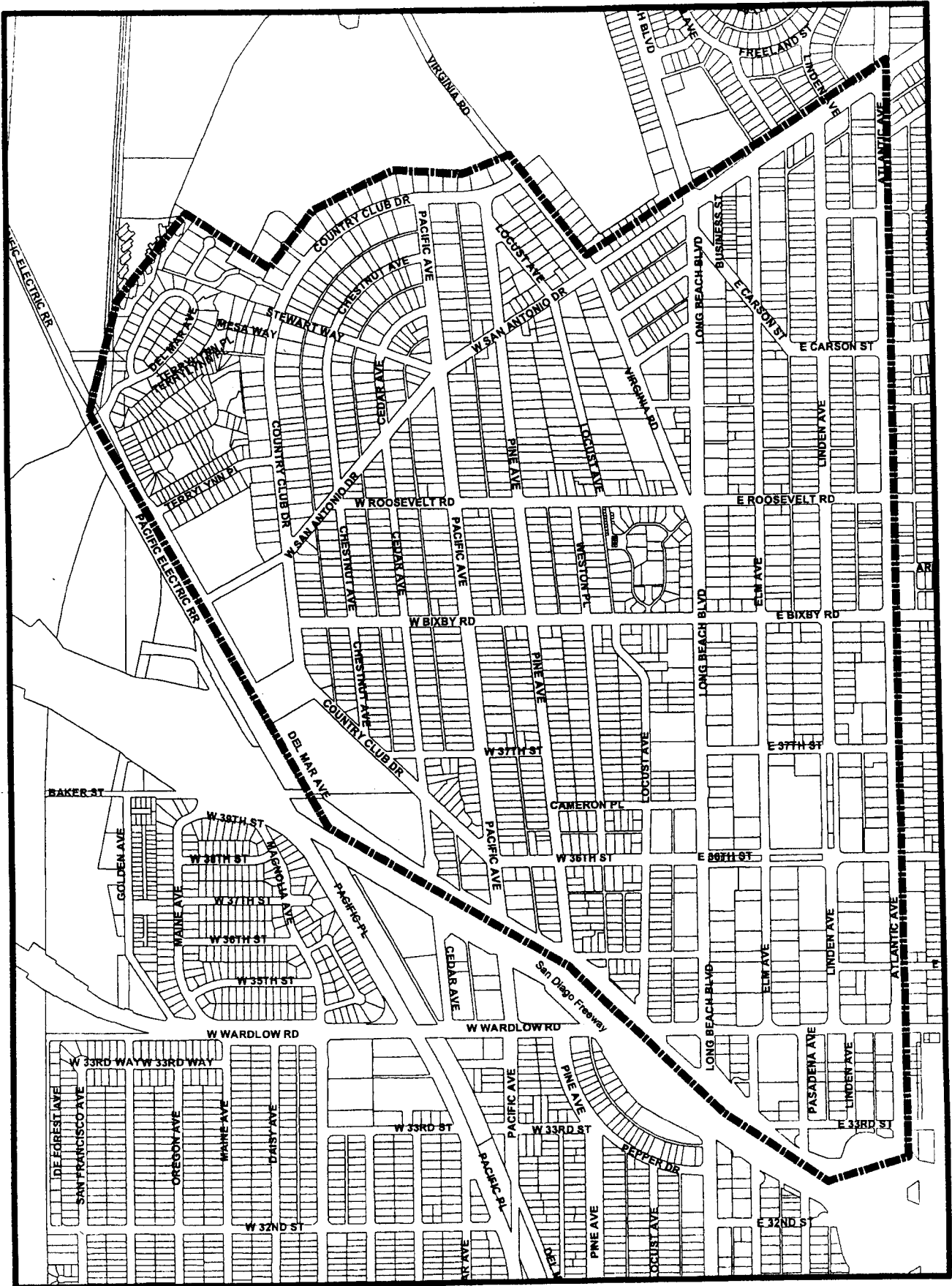

3 exterior property line and the fence shall be landscaped.

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5 Section 2. Declaration of Urgency. This ordinance is an emergency
6 measure, and it is urgently required for the reason that, pending completion of the
7 necessary planning study, and a determination relative to the potential need to amend
8 the Code, it is necessary to limit construction or development in order to avoid the
9 adverse impacts associated with said construction that might be inconsistent with the
10 pending revisions to the zoning or building regulations of the City being considered
11 during the interim period.

12 Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance duly adopted by
13 the City Council by a vote of five of its members and shall take effect immediately. The
14 City Clerk shall certify to a separate roll call and vote on the question of the emergency
15 of this ordinance and to its passage by the vote of five members of the City Council of
16 the City of Long Beach, and cause the same to be posted in three conspicuous places
17 in the City of Long Beach.

18 This ordinance shall also be adopted by the City Council as a regular
19 ordinance, to the end that in the event of any defect or invalidity in connection with the
20 adoption of this ordinance as an emergency ordinance, the same shall, nevertheless, be
21 and become effective on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor.

22 The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City
23 Council of the City of Long Beach and shall cause the same to be posted in three
24 conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.

25 I hereby certify that on a separate roll call and vote which was taken by
26 the City Council of the City of Long Beach upon the question of emergency of this
27 ordinance at its meeting of _____, 2008, the ordinance was declared
28 to be an emergency by the following vote:
