A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACQUIRE PARK TREE INVENTORY SERVICES THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS AND WEST COAST ARBORISTS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire tree inventory services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Agoura Hills issued a Request for Proposals for Professional Tree Inventory and Maintenance Services and entered into a contract with West Coast Arborists, Inc. ("Agoura Hills Contract") for said tree inventory and maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Agoura Hills Contract will facilitate acquisition of tree inventory services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Agoura Hills Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with West Coast Arborists, Inc. for park tree inventory services on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Agoura Hills in an amount not to exceed \$199,000, with the option of renewing for one additional one-year period.


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
