3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ZONAR  
6 SYSTEMS, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS,  
7 FOR THE PURCHASE OF GLOBAL POSITIONING  
8 SYSTEM (GPS) MONITORING SERVICES AND  
9 HARDWARE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, WITH AN  
10 OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR  
11 PERIODS, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED  
12 \$304,854

13  
14 WHEREAS, the City currently has GPS systems on 401 City vehicles  
15 assigned to various City departments; and

16 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau plans to expand the installation to  
17 include an additional 251 vehicles in FY13-14 with complete City fleet coverage by the  
18 end of FY15; and

19 WHEREAS, Zonar Systems, Inc. is the sole supplier for the existing GPS  
20 monitoring systems; and

21 WHEREAS, other GPS systems will not interface with the Zonar GPS  
22 monitoring systems; and

23 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising  
24 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary  
25 expenditure of public funds because Zonar Systems, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or  
26 individual that could or would bid for the furnishing of these GPS monitoring services and  
27 hardware to the City;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

1 follows:

2 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract  
3 with Zonar Systems, Inc. without advertising for bids for the purchase of GPS monitoring  
4 services and hardware as may be required by the City for a period of two (2) years in an  
5 annual amount not to exceed \$304,854, including tax. The parties may, by mutual  
6 agreement, extend the term for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each at the  
7 same annual amount. If the sole source status of Zonar Systems, Inc. changes, City  
8 shall publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

9 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
10 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

11 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City  
12 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of July 9, 2013 by the
