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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH EXPANDING THE USES OF THE
BELMONT SHORE PARKING METER REVENUE FUND

WHEREAS, the City Appropriations Ordinance has established the Belmont
Shore Parking Meter Revenue Fund, which governs the use of funds collected from
parking meters in the Belmont Shore area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to expand the boundaries of this
area and the uses for which such funds may be expended;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as
follows:

Section 1. The Belmont Shore Parking Meter fund shall be a continuing
fund and shall be for the purpose of accounting for revenues from parking meters located
within that part of the Belmont Shore area of the City depicted on the map attached
hereto as Attachment "A". Any expenditures from the Belmont Shore Parking Revenue
Fund are hereby expressly limited to and shall be only authorized for the purposes of
acquisition, construction, improvement, operation or maintenance (including all services
and supplies) of City parking lots, parking facilities, or parking related equipment or
fixtures; for subsidization of bus passes for employees of businesses located in the area
described in Attachment No. "A"; and for traffic signals, street lighting, street furniture,
landscaping, project art and other appurtenant work and improvements to streets, curbs,
gutters and sidewalks on public streets and alleys located within or which are for the
benefit of the area described in Attachment "A"; or the Bay Shore branch of the Long
Beach Public Library.

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Section 2. Ordinance No. ORD-08-0012 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.

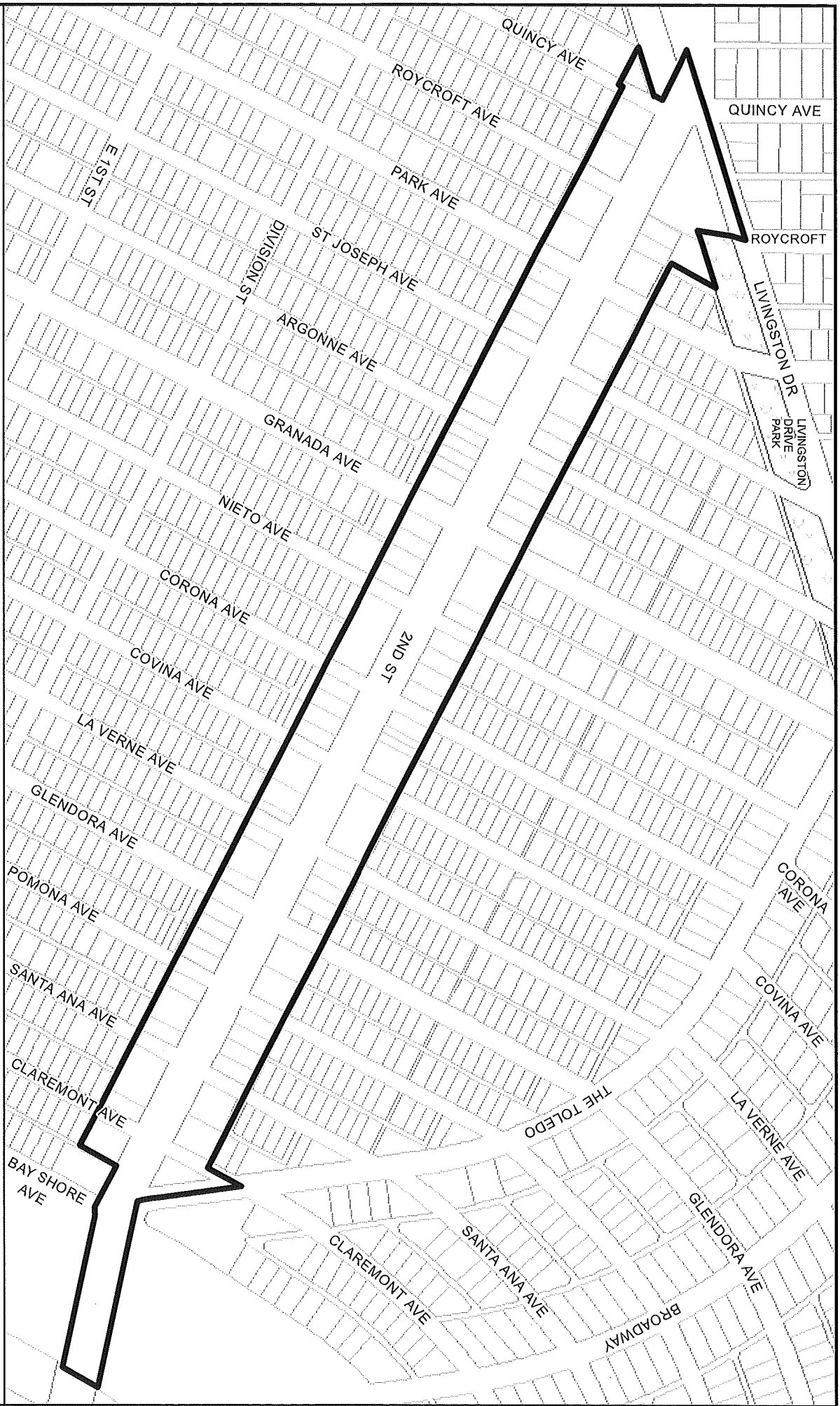
