3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT
6 AND ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS INCLUDING
7 SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS, WITH SAFEWARE, INC.
8 OF LANHAM, MD; AND MALLORY SAFETY AND SUPPLY,
9 LLC, OF PORTLAND, OR, TO FURNISH AND DELIVER
10 EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND PUBLIC SAFETY
11 EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, ON THE SAME TERMS AND
12 CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO PORT OF PORTLAND,
13 OREGON, THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS, IN AN ANNUAL
14 AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000, WITH A 20
15 PERCENT CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600,000,
16 FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO
17 EXCEED \$3,600,000, UNTIL THE OMNIA PARTNERS
18 CONTRACT EXPIRES ON APRIL 1, 2026, WITH THE
19 OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE OMNIA
20 PARTNERS CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE
21 DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

23 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the
24 City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government
25 agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when
26 authorized by resolution; and

27 WHEREAS, the City desires to have furnished and delivered, emergency
28 response and public safety equipment and supplies; and

1 WHEREAS, the Port of Portland through Omnia Partners has a Contract for
2 the purchase of these emergency response and public safety equipment and supplies,
3 Contract Nos. 159469 and 159498 (“Port”); and

4 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the Port Contract will facilitate the City’s
5 ability to purchase emergency response and public safety equipment and supplies, as well
6 as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

7 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
8 participate in the Port Contract considerably more funds would be required;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
10 follows:

11 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
12 herein by this reference.

13 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an
14 agreement with Safeware, Inc. and Mallory Safety and Supply, LLC for furnishing and
15 delivering emergency response and public safety equipment and supplies, on the same
16 terms and conditions afforded to the Port of Portland, Oregon through Omnia Partners
17 Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Omnia Partners, and the
18 purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the Port of
19 Portland, Oregon in an annual aggregate amount of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000),
20 with a 20 percent contingency in the amount of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000),
21 for a total annual aggregate contract amount not to exceed Three Million Six Hundred
22 Thousand Dollars (\$3,600,000), until the Omnia Partners contract expires on April 1, 2026,
23 with the option to renew for as long as the Omnia Partners contract is in effect, at the
24 discretion of the City Manager.

25 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
26 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
