4	entered, in duplicate, as of December 1, 2008 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a
5	minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on
6	August 19, 2008, by and between PALP, INC. DBA EXCEL PAVING COMPANY, a
7	California corporation ("Contractor"), whose address is 2230 Lemon Avenue, Long
8	Beach, California 90806, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation
9	("City").
10	WHEREAS, pursuant to a "Notice Inviting Bids for Improvement of 7th
11	Street Between Redondo Avenue and Pacific Coast Highway in the City of Long Beach,
12	California," dated March 12, 2008, and published by City, bids were received, publicly
13	opened and declared on the date specified in said Notice; and
14	WHEREAS, the City Manager accepted the bid of Contractor; and
15	WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager to enter a
16	contract with Contractor for the work described in Plans & Specifications No. R-6722; and
17	WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the contract amount by an
18	amount not to exceed \$500,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,713,347;
19	NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in
20	the Agreement and in this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:
21	1. Section 3.A. of Contract No. 30640 is amended in its entirety to read
22	as follows:
23	"3. PRICE AND PAYMENT.
24	A. During the original term of the Contract, City shall pay to
25	Contractor the amount(s) for materials and work identified in Contractor's "Bid for
26	Improvement of 7th Street Between Redondo Avenue and Pacific Coast Highway
27	in the City of Long Beach, California," attached to the Contract as Exhibit "A".
28	During the First Amendment, City shall pay to Contractor the amount(s) for

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materials and work identified in Contract Change Order Authorization No. 1, 1 2 attached hereto as Exhibit "A-1"." 3 2.
