**RECOMMENDATION:**

Increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$500, offset by the Third Council District One-Time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide a contribution to the Boy Scouts of America Long Beach Area Chapter for their annual Distinguished Citizen Dinner; and

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$500 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.

**INTRODUCTION:**

The Boy Scouts of America prioritize community service, helping others, and civic engagement. With this emphasis, they provide a positive benefit to Long Beach and instill a sense of responsibility and leadership in our youth. As a result, it is appropriate for the City of Long Beach to support the Boy Scouts of America Long Beach Area Chapter.

This item has been reviewed by Recovery Budget Officer Dee Okam on September 25, 2022.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to the Boy Scouts of America Long Beach Area Chapter for their annual Distinguished Citizen Dinner. The total appropriation increase of \$500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Third Council District One-Time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. This recommendation is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond normal budgeted scope of duties and have a minimal impact on City Council priorities. There is no local job impact associated with this item.
