DISCUSSION:



The Economic Development and Finance Committee on September 20, 2016, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of three Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Ronald Knopp, based upon 1) a 12 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, 2) a 53 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 3) a 64 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
