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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR

BIDS. FOR SERRF ASH DISPOSAL

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WHEREAS, the City, as member of a joint powers authority ("JPA"), owns the Southeast Resource Recovery Facility ("SERRF") and is responsible for its operation and maintenance, including disposal of the ash it produces; and

WHEREAS, SERRF had a long-standing agreement with the County Sanitation District to dispose of its ash at no cost to SERRF at the County's Puente Hills landfill, which possessed permits from the Southern California Regional Water Quality Control Board to receive incinerator ash, for which the City receives AB 939 diversion credits: and

WHEREAS, the Puente Hills landfill is scheduled to cease operation October 31, 2013 and SERRF must now find a facility with the appropriate permits to accept SERRF's ash; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management, Inc. owns the El Sobrante landfill in Riverside County, which is the only landfill in Southern California which is permitted by the Southern California Regional Water Quality Control Board to accept incinerator ash such as SERRF's; and

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids since Waste Management, Inc. is the only entity permitted to accept incinerator ash and to conduct a competitive procurement process would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

follows:

Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to enter a contract, without advertising for bids, with Waste Management, Inc. for waste ash disposal from the SERRF facility to El Sobrante for a period of two (2) years with five (5) additional one (1) year options to extend the agreement at the City Manager's discretion. If the sole source status of Waste Management, Inc. changes, City shall publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
