FIFTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 35579

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 35579 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of February 16, 2022, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on April 14, 2020, by and between MJK CONSTRUCTION, INC., a California corporation ("Contractor"), whose address is 4780 Cheyenne Way, Chino, CA 91710, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Contract No. 35579 (the "Contract") whereby Contractor agreed to remove and replace two 12,000-gallon underground storage fuel tanks located at the Water Department Maintenance Yard at 1800 E. Wardlow Road; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to update the List of Subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to update the List of Subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to update the List of Subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fourth Amendment to add new subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, the Parties currently desire to enter into a Fifth Amendment to extend the contract term and amend the terms of the liquidated damages clause; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 4. of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows.
- "4. <u>TIME FOR CONTRACT</u>. Contractor shall commence work on a date to be specified in a written notice to Proceed from City and shall complete all work by June 11, 2022, subject to strikes, lockouts and events beyond the control of the

Contractor. Time is of the essence hereunder. City will suffer damage if the work is not completed within the time stated, but those damages would be difficult or impractical to determine. So, Contractor shall pay to City, as liquidated damages, the amount stated in the Contract Documents."

Section 33 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows: 2.

"33. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES.

- This fueling system is the primary fueling location for the Long Beach Water Department vehicles. Protracted downtime will result in a financial burden on the City. As a result, this contract includes a provision for liquidated damages.
- B. Removing the existing UST system and installing and commissioning a new system are estimated to take eighteen (18) weeks (six (6) weeks Planning and Permitting, twelve (12) weeks construction).
- C. If the fueling system is out of commission for more than thirtyfive (35) weeks, the contractor agrees to pay the City Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each day beyond the thirty-five (35) weeks that the system is out of commission."
- Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions 3. contained in Contract No. 35579 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
