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RESOLUTION NO. RES-14-0006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH HALCORE GROUP, INC. DBA LEADER EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN AMBULANCES THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,917,470

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase seven (7) Navistar Terrastar/Leader S172 Custom Ambulances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Newport Beach has a contract for the purchase of emergency ambulance medical vehicles, Contract No. 5365 ("Newport Beach Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Newport Beach Contract will facilitate timely acquisition of the seven (7) Navistar Terrastar/Leader S172 Custom Ambulances as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the Newport Beach Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated

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1 herein by this reference.

2 Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an  
3 agreement with Halcore Group, Inc. dba Leader Emergency Vehicles for the purchase of  
4 seven (7) Navistar Terrastar/Leader S172 Custom Ambulances, on substantially the  
5 same terms as the City of Newport Beach except as modified by mutual agreement of the  
6 City and Halcore Group, Inc. dba Leader Emergency Vehicles, and the purchase by the  
7 City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Newport Beach in  
8 an amount not to exceed \$1,917,470.

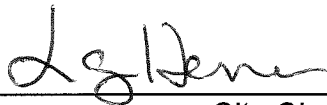
9 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
10 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
