

Who We Are






- ASK Long Beach is a 501(c)(3), non-profit organization.
- Our focus is to provide an alternative to the streets and gangs through healthy activities, education, art and community involvement.
- Our founder and Executive Director, Mike Donelon, has led this grassroots movement for the last 15 years.
- ASK LB proves that the act of engaging our youth has a positive effect in Long Beach by lowering crime in our low-income neighborhoods.
- Our continued efforts will provide further safe environments for our youth to grow, stay out of gangs and remain in school.

Why we do it









- Today's environment is filled with negative factors such as the recession, unemployment and budget cuts. Our atrisk youth in the community are often overlooked because of these issues.
- These kids already struggle with difficult social environments such as physical and mental abuse, violence, crime, substance abuse and poor academic performance. To cope many of our youth, turn to the streets and gangs.
- In Long Beach alone there are approximately over 3000 kids that participate in Action Sports.
- We have shown that something as simple as opening a skate park can have a huge impact on the community
 - Within three years of the opening of the Michael K. Green skate park in 2003 drug related incidents have dropped 60.9%, violent crime has dropped 29.3% and overall incidents have dropped 22.8%. Calls for service have dropped 23%.

Our Solution

- We have proven that as a community we can work together to help them in three major areas:
 - Safe environments create places where youth can focus on positive activities and not negative external influences.
 - Activities provide events, programs and other resources where youth can showcase their talents.
 - Education demonstrate the importance of school, diversity, and the life skills it teaches so that at-risk youth commit to acquiring an education.

By providing these resources, ASK Long Beach will significantly impact our communities by developing strong, confident kids who grow into positive members of society.




