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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH EMC CORPORATION TO PROVIDE DATA CENTER SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA UNDER THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICIALS (NASPO) VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires data center systems equipment; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of General Services through the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement has an Agreement with the State of Minnesota, Contract No. MNWNC-109 (together "NASPO Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the NASPO Contract will facilitate timely acquisition of the data center systems equipment as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than

2 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
3 follows:

4 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
5 herein by this reference.

6 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
7 an agreement with EMC Corporation to furnish, deliver and install data center systems
8 equipment through their contract with the State of California Department of General
9 Services, on the same terms and conditions afforded to the State of Minnesota, under the
10 National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master
11 Agreement, in an amount not to exceed Eight Million Six Hundred Five Thousand Six
12 Hundred Dollars (\$8,605,600) for the first year; thereafter, in an annual amount not to
13 exceed Two Million Eighty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$2,087,000), for ongoing lifecycle
14 replacement of equipment and new incremental technology growth, until the current
15 contract expires on March 31, 2020, with the option to renew for as long as the NASPO
16 Contract is in effect, as needed.

17 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
18 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
